Scholarship Application Procedures

- Applicants for this student scholarship must be **enrolled full-time** in an accredited **four-year undergraduate or graduate institution** in the U.S. or Canada at the time of application and award. Please be advised that this scholarship is for **currently enrolled** college/university students who have **completed at least one semester**.
- Applicants must be able to attend the convention in Atlanta, GA, and must be able to be physically present at the convention in its entirety on **August 24 & 25** at the InterContinental Hotel Buckhead. Note that this scholarship pays for **full convention access** (not the ERG Summit on Aug. 23), which includes the following:
 - **Aug. 23** (Thursday): Welcome Reception at 5:30 PM
 - **Aug. 24** (Friday): Full day of workshops and keynote speakers, with lunch, until 5 PM. No events after 5 PM except for optional "Network & Nourish" mentoring meal outing at your own cost.
 - **Aug. 24**: Diversity Career Fair, 11 AM to 4 PM (free and open to the public)
 - **Aug. 25** (Saturday): Workshops and keynote speakers until 1 PM. Open afternoon.
 - **Aug. 25**: The ATL Gala
- Attendees will be responsible for transportation to and back from Atlanta, and to the hotel, and also hotel stays during the convention, if desired.
- **Deadline** for submission/application: **August 10, 2018, 5 p.m. U.S. Eastern Daylight Time.**
- **Who is eligible?** Students who are **enrolled full-time** in an accredited **four-year undergraduate or graduate institution** in the U.S. or Canada at the time of application.
- **To submit** your interest, please send an email to students@naaap.org containing the following information:
 1. Full name
 2. City, State and Country where you are currently located
 3. Contact information: **email and phone**
 4. **Name of college or university** that you are enrolled as a full-time student. Attach **evidence of this enrollment** (e.g. class enrollment confirmation, or an enrollment statement from the University Registrar, or any official college or university document that shows that you are currently enrolled)
 5. The **major** you have declared (if any)
 6. Anticipated **graduation** month/year.
 7. **Confirm** that if selected, you can attend the NAAAP National Convention in Atlanta on August 23-25 (*in your email, simply state a "YES" next to this #7 statement*)

8. **Confirm** that if selected and notified by NAAAP, you can and will respond within 48 hours to indicate if you will accept this scholarship (*in your email, simply state a "YES" beside this #8 statement*).
9. Write and submit (or include in the body of the e-mail) a brief essay (max 500 words) in response to this topic: **Tell us a story about your personal leadership experience. Please describe how and where you demonstrated your leadership, and the resulting impact that it produced.**

E-mail your application to students@naaap.org no later than **August 10, 2018, 5 p.m. U.S. EDT**.
Selected students will be notified in just a few days after the deadline.
