PROGRAMS for COLLEGE STUDENTS:

- DST Undergraduate Co-op Program – Central Intelligence Agency (Washington, DC)
 - Focuses on full-time college students currently enrolled in an undergraduate program at an accredited college or university with co-operative programs.
 - For students in a range of hard science programs, particularly electrical engineering, physics, computer engineering, computer science, and physical sciences. Foreign language capability is highly desired. Prior to graduation, students work on an alternating semester or quarterly basis. Co-ops typically work during Fall or Spring semester.
 - Requires a minimum of one three-month work tour but more work tours are desired.
 - Submit application at least 12 months before the desired start date. DST encourages college freshman with one semester completed or sophomores to explore our website, cia.gov, and apply.
- DST College Internship Program – Central Intelligence Agency (Washington, DC)
 - DST Internship focuses on full-time college students currently enrolled in an undergraduate program at an accredited college or university.
 - For students in a range of hard science programs, particularly electrical engineering, physics, computer engineering, computer science, and physical sciences. Foreign language capability is highly desired. Prior to graduation, students work on an alternating semester or quarterly basis. Co-ops typically work during Summer semester.
 - Work tour length is generally 90 days during the Summer months; however, the office and the student agree on the actual length of the work tour. Many students work a minimum of one work tour, but more work tours are desired.
 - Submit application at least 12 months before the desired start date. DST encourages college freshman with one semester completed or sophomores to explore our website, cia.gov, and apply.
